**DISTRICT OF LANTZVILLE
BYLAW NO. 100, 2012**

A BYLAW TO IMPLEMENT A MUNICIPAL TICKETING SYSTEM

WHEREAS the *Community Charter* authorizes Council, by bylaw, to designate those District bylaws which may be enforced by means of a municipal ticketing system; which offences are subject to municipal ticketing; who can issue municipal tickets and what fines may be imposed for each offence.

NOW THEREFORE, the Council of the District of Lantzville, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

1. The bylaws, as amended or replaced from time to time, listed in Column 1 of Schedule A of this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed in Section 273 of the *Community Charter*.
2. In Schedule A of this bylaw, the persons appointed to the job positions or titles listed in Column 2 are designated as bylaw enforcement officers under Section 264 of the *Community Charter* for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1.
3. In Appendices 1 through 8 of this bylaw, the words or expressions in Column 1 designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2.
4. In Appendices 1 through 8 of this bylaw, the amounts appearing in Column 3 are the fines set under Section 265 of the *Community Charter* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1.
5. This bylaw shall take effect upon the date of its adoption.
6. This Bylaw may be cited as “District of Lantzville Municipal Ticket Information Bylaw No. 100, 2012”.
