

MUNICIPAL TICKETING INFORMATION SYSTEM BYLAW

A bylaw to authorize the use of the Municipal Ticketing Information System pursuant to the *Community Charter*, SBC 2003.

WHEREAS the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cranbrook deems it expedient to provide for a bylaw for the purpose of enforcing certain bylaws of the City;

NOW THEREFORE the Council of the Corporation of the City of Cranbrook, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

TITLE

- 1.1 This bylaw may be cited for all purposes as “City of Cranbrook Municipal Ticketing Information System Bylaw No. 3856, 2016”.

DEFINITIONS AND INTERPRETATION

- 1.2 In this bylaw, unless the context otherwise requires:

CORPORATE OFFICER means the employee appointed to that position for the City pursuant to section 146 of the *Community Charter*

CITY means the Corporation of the City of Cranbrook

COUNCIL means the municipal Council of the City

- 1.3 Unless otherwise provided, words and phrases used herein have the same meanings as in the *Community Charter*, *Local Government Act* or *Interpretation Act* as the context and circumstances may require. A reference to a statute in this bylaw refers to a statute of the Province of British Columbia unless otherwise indicated, and a reference to any statute, regulation, bylaw or other enactment refers to that enactment as it may be amended or replaced from time to time. In the event of a conflict between this bylaw and a Provincial enactment, the stricter law prevails. Words in the singular include the plural and words in the plural include the singular, and reference to a gender includes both genders and a corporation. Headings in this bylaw are for convenience only and must not be construed as defining or limiting the scope or intent. If any part of this bylaw is held to be invalid by a court of competent jurisdiction, the invalid part is severed and the remainder continues to be valid.

- 2.1 Schedule A and schedules B1 through B16 inclusive are attached to and form part of this bylaw.

GENERAL PROVISIONS

3.1 The bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A to this bylaw may be enforced by means of a ticket in the form prescribed for the purpose of Chapter 26, Part 8, Division 3 of the *Community Charter*.

3.2 The persons appointed to the positions or titles listed in Column 2 of Schedule A to this bylaw are designated as bylaw enforcement officers pursuant to Section 264(1)(b) of the *Community Charter* for the purpose of enforcing the bylaws listed in Column 1 of Schedule A opposite the respective job positions.

3.3 The words or expressions set forth in Column 1 of Schedules B1 to B16 inclusive to this bylaw designate the offence committed under the bylaw section number appearing in Column 2 of Schedules B1 to B16 inclusive opposite the respective words or expressions.

3.4 The amounts appearing in Column 3 of Schedules B1 to B16 inclusive to this bylaw are the fines established pursuant to Sections 265(1)(a) and 265(1)(b) of the *Community Charter* for the corresponding offences designated in Column 1 of Schedules B1 to B16 inclusive.

3.5 Authorization is hereby delegated to the Corporate Officer to refer tickets issued with respect to this bylaw to the Provincial Court for hearing pursuant to section 269(1) of the *Community Charter*.

REPEAL

4.1 "City of Cranbrook Ticket Information Utilization Bylaw No. 3022, 1991" and all amendments are hereby repealed.
